Low-Income Housing Update

On November 14 the City Planning Commission delayed voting on the low income housing project (Eastdale Station Apartments) planned for Burbank due to a dispute over property ownership. The Commission agreed that they could not approve or deny the construction of the apartments until the matter is resolved. The City Attorneys will decide the fate of this issue.

The low income housing development will not be on the City Planning Commission's agenda again until January 23,

2003. Originally it was scheduled for discussion on December 12, however, Montgomery Mayor Bobby Bright requested that Fred Bennett, the contractor for the proposed construction, ask for a delay so that Bennett and leaders in the Montgomery East Area who oppose the project can come together to discuss pertinent issues. Mayor Bright has asked Jon Dow, the Executive Director of BONDS (Building Our Neighborhoods for Development and Success), to act as a mediator between the two sides. This
