Welcome Wynbrook neighbors and WNA members to the end of Spring! Our June WNA meeting is coming up on Tuesday, June 15, then it is Father's Day and the official start of Summer. I got a kick out of driving through the neighborhood on Memorial Day. One benefit of being a WNA member is getting informed of city services, among other things. It seemed like only WNA members knew that Memorial Day (Monday, May 31) was a garbage pick-up day. You could almost tell who was a WNA member based on whether a green trash can was in front of that house on Memorial Day. As I mentioned, our next meeting will be on Tuesday, June 15 at 6:30 p.m. by the Wynbrook welcome sign. Please bring a lawn chair and come join us for a great meeting. She was rained-out last month, but for June, we will feature Susan Carmichael from the Montgomery Clean City Commission. She'll be talking about recycling, gardening programs, and much more.
