Fred Bennett, contractor for the low income housing complex planned for Burbank, has reapplied for recognition at the City Planning Commission Meeting on Thursday, November 14 at 5:00 p.m. Bennett was originally scheduled on September agenda but withdrew when City Councilman Pep Pilgreen resigned as engineer on the project. Wynbrook residents, please take action now to stop these apartments from coming to our area. The City Planning Commission needs to hear from us; they need to know that

we're serious about the quality of life in Wynbrook and do not want the value of our homes to decrease from this new construction. You may contact Planning Commission members at 241-2722. Remember, we want them to help us, so please be polite and friendly as you express your opinion. The new engineers for the project, Goodwyn Mills and Cawood can be contacted at 271-3200. Let them know that Wynbrook and the surrounding community does not support the proposed construction.
